Last week Scott Riley, Deb Mainwaring and I from Council together with six staff members from the Circular Head Aboriginal Corporation attended the first breakfast for the Reconciliation of Tasmania. This was a great event with a thought provoking talk delivered by Mark Gooda who is a descendant of the Gangulu People of Central Queensland.

You may have noticed some recent activity with the construction of the Circular Head Community Wellbeing Centre and it's pleasing to see this project coming along nicely. Stubbs Constructions have recently completed leakage testing of the two swimming pools and finished the balance tank roofs. The next steps will be constructing the buildings over and around the swimming pools with Stubbs having commenced the foundation and concrete slab works. It is anticipated the walls and roof of the new building will begin to take shape over June and July. We are still aiming to have the work completed so that the facility will be opened in December this year. I look forward to bringing you further updates on the progress of this project.
