Often I am asked about laws regarding parking in our streets in Smithton and Stanley and why we do not fine people for either parking in invalid or no standing spots. Other issues include business workers parking in the streets and motorists not parking within the lines provided. Police are responsible for some of these issues but not all, and Council does not have staff to regulate parking. I would hope all motorists remember to adhere to the signs that are in place for important reasons so we do not have the need to start prosecuting. There are plenty of car parks off both King and Smith Streets if parking is not available on the side of streets. Please think of others when parking.

Last week I attended an information session for those considering standing for Council at the forthcoming elections in September and October. It was encouraging to see over 40 people attend this event with a large number intending to nominate. I would encourage others to continue thinking about standing for this rewarding role in our communities.
