



CIRCULAR HEAD MAYOR DARYL QUILLIAM'S MESSAGE 31 JULY 2018

Last week I attended the presentations for the North West Fire Service medals for this year for their volunteers. There were almost 100 medals presented with services between 45 and five years of service with a number being National medals. A number of these were from Circular Head which was pleasing to see.

Recently I had the privilege of welcoming 270 teachers to our community from Christian Schools from all over Tasmania. These teachers not only held their annual conference in Smithton but they also had the opportunity of visiting various tourism destinations in our district.

At the recent July Council meeting Council voted in favour of a recommendation to become a member of the B4 Early Years Coalition. The Coalition is a State Government initiative supported through the Department of Education to work together with families and the community to improve outcomes for children in the early years. The name B4 represents the early years of a child's life, pregnancy to age four, the years 'before' a child begins full-time school and the period before birth. Circular Head Council joins a number of schools, early childhood centres and other organisations as members of the Coalition, as well as Waratah-Wynyard Council who were the first Council to join in May.

During the closed session discussions were held in relation to the appointment of an operator to manage the Circular Head Community Wellbeing Centre. We expect an announcement to be made on this shortly, so please keep an eye for further information.
